The club believes that it is important that colts, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect, be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Group Coach or **Steve Park, Chairman of the Colts Section**.

- As a member of Sunbury Hockey Club Colts Section you are expected to abide by the following Colts club rules:
- All Colts must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All Colts must respect opponents.
- All Colts should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- All Colts must wear suitable kit for training and the club kit for matches, as agreed with the coach/team manager. The wearing of a gumshield and shinpads is compulsory and without these the colt will not be permitted to play.
- All fees for training or events must be paid promptly.
- All Colts are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- All Colts are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
